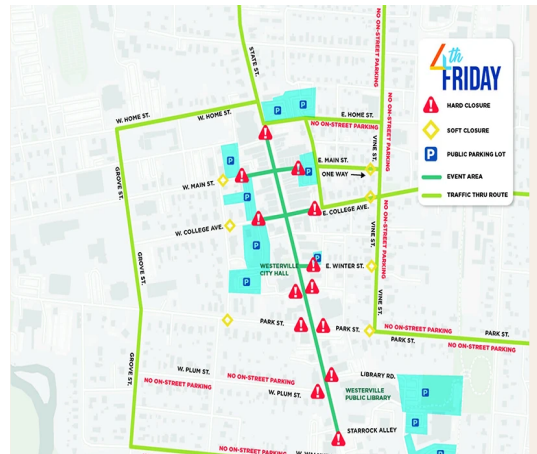

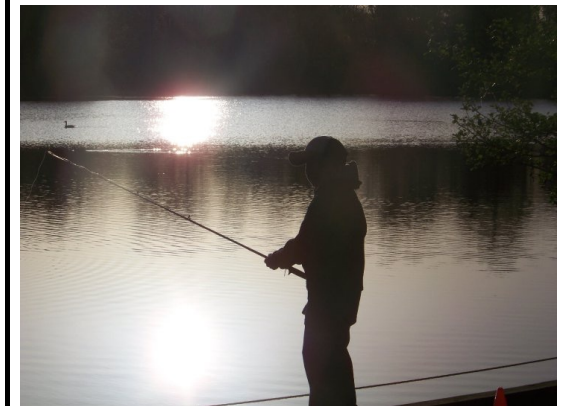

The "Go Fish" game will also be back.

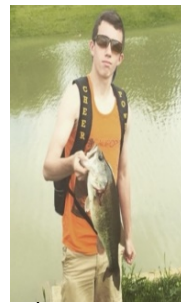
Tickets \$10 each/5 for \$40.

The purpose of this Foundation is to pass Zak's love for fishing on by supporting the fishing clubs that meant so much to him. It is our way of honoring his memory and to pass his love for fishing to future generations by giving back to the community he grew up in and loved.

Zak Davis was an amazing young man who loved to try new things. He enjoyed the time he spent with his family and friends. His smile was infectious and he was always trying to make people laugh.

His shenanigans were widely known!

He was a true Bengals fan and cheered them on each and every year.

He was also a fan of The Ohio State Buckeyes football and basketball programs.

Zak was a wrestler, competitive cheerleader, football player, class officer and an amazing Ultimate Frisbee player. But **NOTHING** compared to his love for **FISHING!** From the age of five, Zak was an avid fisherman. At the age of 12 he acquired a professional sponsorship from

Economical Bass Baits.

During his middle school years he was a member of the Walnut Springs Fishing Club and in high school he fished with Hartley's Hawks.

Zak competed in many state tournaments and won many awards as a youth fisherman.

He placed 3rd on the Middle School Team, and 1st on Hartley's Hawks Team, and placed 17th in the state the same year.

Zak **LOVED** to teach his friends to fish and was always willing to pass on his fishing knowledge.

A fishing rod and bait were standard equipment in his car.

Zak was tragically killed in a car accident in December 2019 at the age of 21.
